#### ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION AND ORDER; PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, LOWER BUCKS DAM GEOMEMBRANE PROJECT (5A32CR00197A2), PLUMAS COUNTY

This Order responds to the 10 December 2019 request for an amendment of the Lower Bucks Dam Geomembrane Project (WDID No. 5A32CR00197A1). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 16 July 2019 and an amendment was issued on 7 October 2019. The request for amendment is hereby approved. The original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

## AMENDMENT:

Pacific Gas & Electric Company is requesting an amendment to the Section 401 Water Quality Certification and Order to change the temporary impacts from 11.24 acres to 9.28 acres and remove the permanent impact of 0.057 acre. In addition, Pacific Gas and Electric Company is requesting that all compensatory mitigation for permanent impacts be removed. Therefore, Section VII, Table 1; Section XII.K; and Attachment B, Table 2 of the Water Quality Certification are replaced as shown below. Section XII.K, Table 4; and Attachment B, Table 3 have been omitted.

## VII. Description of Direct Impacts to Waters of the State

Total Project fill/excavation quantities for all impacts are summarized in Table 1. Permanent impacts are categorized as those resulting in a physical loss in area and also those degrading ecological condition only.
