NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY FOR COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL ORDER NO. R5-2019-0023, WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 WATER QUALITY CERTIFCATION OF THE SOUTH SACRAMENTO HABITAT CONSERVATION PLAN PROGRAMMATIC GENERAL PERMIT, GERBER CREEK UNIT 1 PROJECT (WDID#5A34CR00759-015), SACRAMENTO COUNTY

On 20 July 2021, Lennar (Permittee) submitted a Notice of Intent (NOI) to enroll under and comply with Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) General Order R5-2019-0023, Waste Discharge Requirements and Clean Water Act Section 401 Water Quality Certification of the South Sacramento Habitat Conservation Plan Programmatic General Permit.

The Central Valley Water Board has reviewed your enrollment materials and finds the Gerber Creek Unit 1 Project (Project) meets the requirements of, and is hereby enrolled under, General Order R5-2019-0023. You may proceed with your Project in accordance with the Order.

Please familiarize yourself with the requirements of General Order R5-2019-0023. You are responsible for complying with all applicable Order requirements. Failure to comply with General Order No. R5-2019-0023 constitutes a violation of the California Water Code and may result in enforcement action or termination of enrollment under the Order.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The 20.3-acre Project will prepare the area for a new residential housing development and associated on-site infrastructure. Permanent impacts to aquatic resources will result from rough grading, infrastructure development, and pad development. The Project will

permanently affect 1.13 acre of vernal pools and seasonal wetlands (collectively referred to as vernal pools).

No dewatering will occur in the project area. No wet concrete will be placed into waters of the state. Temporarily impacted areas will be restored to pre-project condition.

PROJECT TYPE:

Residential

ADDITIONAL CONDITION:

The Applicant shall obtain coverage under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) General Permit for Storm Water Discharges Associated with Construction and Land Disturbance Activities Order No. 2009-0009-DWQ, as amended for discharges to surface waters comprised of storm water associated with construction activity, including, but not limited to, demolition, clearing, grading, excavations, and other land disturbance activities of one of more acres, or where projects disturb less than one acre but are part of a larger common plan of development that in total disturbs one or more acres.

PROJECT LOCATION:

The Project is located at McCoy Avenue and Elk Grove Florin Road in Sacramento.

Section 1, Township 7 North, Range 5 East MDB&M

Latitude: 38.486217° N and Longitude: 121.374372° W

PROJECT SCHEDULE:

Construction is expected to begin in October 2021 and complete in December 2023.

COMPENSATORY MITIGATION

A copy of the fully executed agreements for the purchase of mitigation credits shall be provided to the Central Valley Water Board prior to the initiation of in-water work.

The Permittee shall retain responsibility for providing the compensatory mitigation and long-term management until Central Valley Water Board staff has received documentation of the credit purchase and the transfer agreement between the Permittee and the seller of credits.

The Permittee shall purchase 1.13 acre of vernal pool credits from the South Sacramento In-Lieu Fee Program prior to the initiation of in-water work for the permanent impacts to 1.13 acre of vernal pool habitat.

APPLICATION FEE RECEIVED:

An application fee of \$21,360.00 was received on 23 July 2021. The fee amount was determined as required by California Code of Regulations, title 23, sections 3833(b)(3) and 2200(a)(3), and was calculated as A - Fill & Excavation Discharges (fee code 84) with the dredge and fill fee calculator.

PROJECT SPECIFIC AVOIDANCE AND MINIMIZATION MEASURES:

The Permittee shall implement the site-specific avoidance and minimization measures (AMMs) outlined in Attachment 4 of the South Sacramento Habitat Conservation Plan for the Gerber Creek Unit 1 Project.

WATER QUALITY MONITORING:

No sampling is required for the filling of 1.13 acre of vernal pool habitat.






Figure 1: Project Location Map




Figure 2: Impacts to Waters of the State
