ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 TECHNICALLY CONDITIONED WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION; ESI DESIGN SERVICES, INC., U.S. FOODS DISTRIBUTION CENTER AT MCCLELLAN PARK PROJECT (WDID#5A34CR00778A1), SACRAMENTO COUNTY

This Order responds to the 28 January 2020 request for an amendment of the U.S. Foods Distribution Center at McClellan Park Project (Project) Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WDID#5A34CR00778). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 7 January 2020. The requested amendment is hereby approved. The original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

AMENDMENT:

ESI Design Services, Inc. (Applicant) is requesting an amendment to update the compensatory mitigation section required by the original Certification. The original Certification required the Applicant to purchase 0.324 vernal pool creation and 0.003 wetland creation credits.

The Certification is amended as shown below:

30. To mitigate for the loss of 0.078 acre of wetland habitat and 0.087 of stream channel habitat, the Applicant shall purchase a minimum of 0.08 wetland re-establishment and 0.09 shaded riverine aquatic re-establishment mitigation credits from a United States Army Corps of Engineers approved mitigation bank or in lieu fee program or as required by the United States Army Corps of Engineers for the impacted watershed prior to commencing construction. The Applicant shall provide evidence of all off-site compensatory mitigation to the Central Valley Water Board. At a minimum, compensatory mitigation must achieve a ratio of 1:1 for permanent impacts.

Compensatory Mitigation: To mitigate for the loss of 0.078 acre of wetland habitat and 0.087 acre of stream channel habitat, the Applicant shall purchase a minimum of 0.08 wetland re-establishment and 0.09 shaded riverine aquatic re-establishment mitigation credits from a United States Army Corps of Engineers approved mitigation bank or as required by the United States Army Corps of Engineers for the impacted watershed prior to commencing construction. The Applicant shall provide evidence of all off-site compensatory mitigation to the Central Valley Water Board. At a minimum, compensatory mitigation must achieve a ratio of 1:1 for permanent impacts.

Evidence of this purchase shall be provided to the Central Valley Water Board prior to proceeding with the activity authorized by this Certification.
