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NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY FOR COVERAGE UNDER ORDER NO. 2023-0058-DWQ, STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES OF DREDGED OR FILL MATERIAL TO WATERS OF THE STATE FROM EMERGENCY REPAIR AND PROTECTION ACTIVITIES, SACRAMENTO COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, CLAY STATION ROAD BRIDGE REPAIR AT BROWNS CREEK PROJECT (WDID# 5A34CR00921), SACRAMENTO COUNTY

On 9 June 2025, the Sacramento County Department of Transportation (Permittee) filed a notification requesting coverage under the 13 July 2023 State Water Resources Control Board Order No. 2023-0058-DWQ, Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Dredged or Fill Material to Waters of the State from Emergency Repair and Protection Activities (General Dredge or Fill WDR). The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) has reviewed the enrollment materials and finds the Clay Station Road Bridge Repair at Browns Creek Project (Project) meets the requirements of, and is hereby enrolled under, Order No. 2023-0058-DWQ. The Permittee may proceed with the Project in accordance with the Order.

Please familiarize yourself with the requirements of Order No. 2023-0058-DWQ. The Permittee is responsible for complying with all applicable Order requirements. Failure to comply with Order No. 2023-0058-DWQ constitutes a violation of the California Water Code and may result in enforcement action or termination of enrollment under the General Dredge or Fill WDR.

The Project is being conducted in accordance with the requirements contained in this Notice of Applicability and General Dredge or Fill WDR. The Project is described in the

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notification form requesting coverage under the General Dredge or Fill WDR, dated 9 June 2025, and supplementary information (Application Package). Coverage under the General Dredge or Fill WDR is no longer valid if the Project (as described) is modified.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The 0.03-acre Clay Station Road Bridge Repair at Browns Creek Project (Project) consists of the construction of temporary bents to support the bridge superstructure. Compacted aggregate base will be used at the base of the wood beams. Equipment and material staging will be out of the creek, along Clay Station Road. Cofferdams will be used to dewater Browns Creek upstream and downstream of the bridge.

The Project will permanently impact 0.00031 acre/9 linear feet and temporarily impact 0.0235 acre/24.3 linear feet of waters of the United States.

PROJECT SCHEDULE:

The Sacramento County Department of Transportation will submit a Project schedule to Central Valley Water Board staff once it has been decided.

APPLICATION FEE RECEIVED:

An application fee of \$4,212.00 was received on 12 June 2025.

The fee amount was determined as required by California Code of Regulations, title 23, sections 3833(b)(3) and 2200(a)(3), and was calculated as category F – Emergency Projects authorized by a General Order (fee code 85) with the dredge and fill fee calculator.

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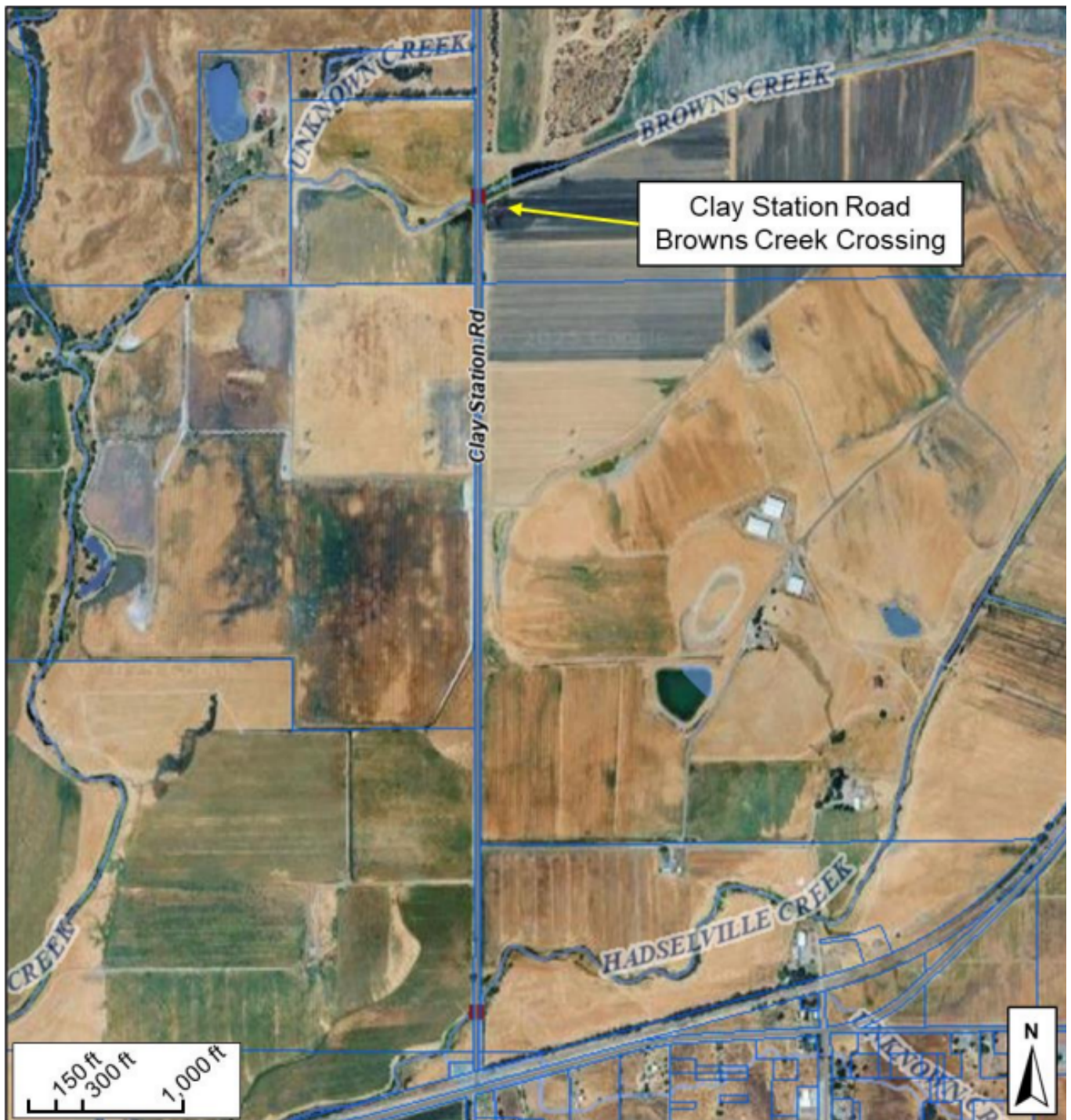


Figure 1: Project Location
