ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION AND ORDER; TWIN LAKES MOBILE ESTATES, TWIN LAKES MOBILE ESTATES - SEDIMENT REMOVAL AND BANK RESTORATION PROJECT (5A45CR00548A1), SHASTA COUNTY

This Order responds to the 23 October 2019 Construction Summary and Request for Notice of Completion of Discharges and Project Complete Letter. In addition, the letter requests verification of the Certification Deviation for the Sediment Removal and Bank Restoration Project (WDID No. 5A45CR00548). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 11 June 2018. The request for Certification Deviation is hereby approved. However, the Certification Deviation requires the Order be formally amended to reflect all authorized Certification Deviations and any resulting adjustments to the amount of water resource impacts and required compensatory mitigation amounts after the termination of construction. The original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

AMENDMENT:

Twin Lakes Estates is requesting an amendment to the Section 401 Water Quality Certification and Order to change the temporary impacts from 0.117 acre to 0.148 acre and permanent impacts from 0.003 acre to 0.0072 acre. No compensatory mitigation was required for the Sediment Removal and Bank Restoration Project. Therefore, Section VII, Table 2 and Attachment B, Table 2 of the Water Quality Certification are replaced with the new tables shown below.

VII. Description of Direct Impacts to Waters of the State

Total Project fill/excavation quantities for all impacts are summarized in Table 2. Permanent impacts are categorized as those resulting in a physical loss in area and also those degrading ecological condition only.
