ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 TECHNICALLY CONDITIONED WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION; LIBERTY ISLAND HOLDINGS II, INC, NORTH DELTA LIBERTY ISLAND II FISH CONSERVATION BANK PROJECT (WDID# 5A57CR00198A2), YOLO COUNTY

This Order responds to the 11 April 2025 request for an amendment of the North Delta Liberty Island II Fish Conservation Bank Project (Project) Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WDID#5A57CR00198). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 25 August 2021. The Certification was amended on 28 June 2024. The requested second amendment is hereby approved. The original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

AMENDMENT:

Liberty Island Holdings II, Inc is requesting a change in the project description. The updated project description will reduce project related impacts and includes onsite riparian restoration proposed as mitigation to offset project related impacts to riparian habitat. The project will create and enhance 811.21 acres of habitat for Delta native fish species within the Yolo Bypass by removing sections of the levee to allow for increased tidal action, creating and restoring tidal marsh complex, removing an existing nonfunctioning water control structure and culvert, and revegetating native marsh vegetation within 32.00 acres. Riparian restoration is proposed within up to 16.09 additional acres. A total of 784.25 acres (94%) (763.11 acres with North Delta Fish Conservation Bank and 21.14 acres within Liberty Conservation Bank) will be preserved (avoided) as part of the Project implementation.

Liberty Island Holdings II, Inc is requesting a change of the aquatic construction date. The original certificate states Aquatic construction activities will be performed outside of the Delta smelt spawning period (1 December to 31 July). The revised date construction activities will occur is (1 May to 1 October).

Liberty Island Holdings II, Inc has provided documentation from the United States Army

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Corps of Engineers (SPK-2010-00755) authorizing in-water construction activities to continue until 24 August 2026.
