NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY; GENERAL SECTION 401 WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION ORDER REQUIREMENTS FOR THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON, POST-CREEK FIRE EMERGENCY DEBRIS FLOW FENCE PROJECT (WDID NO. 5B10CR00111), FRESNO COUNTY

On 5 November 2021, Southern California Edison (Applicant) filed a notification requesting coverage under the 9 October 2018 State Water Resources Control Board Clean Water Act Section 401 General Water Quality Certification of the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Regional General Permit 8 (General Certification Order) for the Post-Creek Fire Emergency Debris Flow Fence Project (Project). After review of the notification and the supplemental material submitted by the Applicant, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) has determined that the Project qualifies for enrollment under this General Certification Order. The proposed activity will take place within less than 0.0014 acre of waters of the United States.

The Central Valley Water Board is certifying this Project under United States Army Corps of Engineers Regional General Permit 8, Emergency Repair and Protection Activities, subject to the conditions and the notification requirements described in the Nationwide Permit ("Special Conditions"). This Notice of Applicability is being issued under the General Certification Order pursuant to Section 3838 of the California Code of Regulations.

under the General Certification Order is no longer valid if the Project (as described) is modified.

# PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The 4.68-acre Project consists of equipment operations within the drainages that are necessary to install debris flow fences at the three installation sites. Work is intended to take place in dry conditions of the side slopes and primarily above any surface flows in a period of runoff following precipitation events. The embedded anchoring systems will be retained for future post-fire response and are considered a permanent discharge. Excavation is necessary to install anchor support ropes and anchors to an embeddedness depth that will be dictated by subsurface substrates encountered during pilot anchor testing. The debris fences are planned to be removed after 5-years of operations.

The Project will permanently impact 0.0014 acre of waters of the United States.

# **PROJECT LOCATION:**

The Project is located near the confluence of Big Creek and the San Joaquin River in the Sierra Nevada Mountains of Fresno County.
