# ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 TECHNICALLY CONDITIONED WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION; CITY OF NEWMAN, NCCA WETLAND PROJECT (WDID NO. 5B24CR00096A1), MERCED COUNTY

This Order responds to the 5 May 2022 request for an amendment of the NCCA Wetland Project (Project) Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WDID No. 5B24CR00096). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 14 January 2022. The requested amendment is hereby approved. The original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

This amendment is not valid until and unless an amendment to the Section 404 Permit with equivalent modifications is approved by the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) or it is otherwise determined by USACE that an amendment of the 404 Permit is unnecessary.

#### AMENDMENT:

The City of Newman (hereinafter Permittee) is requesting an amendment to the Section 401 Water Quality Certification and Order. Temporary disturbance of wetlands has increased to 4.49 acres, up 1.09 acres from the 3.40 acres under the original certification. The increase can be attributed to added grading to expand wetland enhancement in the west portion of the central swale on the 78-acre parcel. An additional portion of the increase is due to the footprint of the construction access route along the west boundary of the 24-acre parcel. Additionally, the total expected wetland to be restored/rehabilitated will decrease from 10.90 acres to 10.545 acres.
