

## RESCISSION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER 2003-0003-DWQ-0008 CONTRA COSTA WATER DISTRICT ROCK SLOUGH FISH SCREEN PROJECT DEWATERING CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

On 8 July 2009, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability granting coverage under the State Water Resources Control Board's Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality (Order 2003-003-DWQ) to Contra Costa Water District. The Notice of Applicability was for temporary discharges of extracted groundwater during construction dewatering for the Contra Costa Canal Intake Rock Slough Fish Screen Project.

Your 22 November 2011 letter and Notice of Termination state that the project has been completed, the discharge has permanently ceased, and you wish to terminate coverage under the General WDRs. Based on that information, coverage under Order 2003-003-DWQ is hereby rescinded.
