

RESCISSION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER 2003-0003-DWQ-0011 CHEVRON PIPE LINE COMPANY SACRAMENTO LEG REPAIRS – SITE 116 SOLANO COUNTY

On 23 April 2010, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability granting coverage under the State Water Resources Control Board's *Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality* (Order 2003-003-DWQ) to Chevron Pipe Line Company. The Notice of Applicability was for temporary discharges of extracted groundwater during trench dewatering for the Sacramento Leg Site 116 pipeline repair project.

Your 21 November 2011 letter and Notice of Termination state that the project has been completed, the discharge has permanently ceased, and you wish to terminate coverage under the General WDRs. Based on that information, coverage under Order 2003-003-DWQ is hereby rescinded.
