RESCISSION OF COVERAGE UNDER WATER QUALITY ORDER 2003-0003-DWQ, STATEWIDE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND WITH A LOW THREAT TO WATER QUALITY, WOODLAND-DAVIS CLEAN WATER AGENCY, DAVIS WOODLAND WATER SUPPLY PROJECT, YOLO COUNTY

On 6 March 2015, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability (NOA) granting coverage under the *Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality* (General Order 2003-0003-DWQ-0133 or General Order) to the Woodland-Davis Clean Water Agency. The NOA was for the temporary discharge of construction dewatering associated with the Davis Woodland Water Supply Project (Project) in Yolo County.

Your 17 January 2017 letter and Notice of Termination states that the project construction activities as described in the NOA are complete, no discharges occurred due to the favorable groundwater elevations at the time of the construction, and that you wish to terminate coverage under the General Order. Based on that information, coverage under Order 2003-0003-DWQ is hereby rescinded.
