On 14 November 2016, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability granting coverage under the State Water Resources Control Board's Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality (Order 2003-003-DWQ) to the City of Manteca for the discharge to land during construction dewatering activities at the Family Entertainment Zone project site.

Your Notice of Termination, dated 31 August 2017, states that no further discharges for construction dewatering will occur and you wish to terminate coverage under the General Waste Discharge Requirements. Based on that information, coverage under Order 2003-003-DWQ-0156 is hereby rescinded.
