RESCISSION OF COVERAGE UNDER WATER QUALITY ORDER 2003-0003-DWQ, STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND WITH A LOW THREAT TO WATER QUALITY, BEACON LAND COMPANY, CONSTRUCTION DEWATERING FOR THE SUNDANCE UNIT 2 PROJECT, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

On 14 November 2016, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) issued a Notice of Applicability granting coverage under the State Water Resources Control Board's *Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality* (General Order; 2003-0003-DWQ) to the Beacon Land Company for construction dewatering.

The Central Valley Water Board received a Notice of Termination on 27 September 2022 stating that discharges to land have ceased. Based on that information, coverage under Order 2003-0003-DWQ-0157 is hereby rescinded.
