TRANSMITTAL OF ORDER RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS, PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC, PIPELINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT R-838; NON-TRADITIONAL IN-LINE INVESTIGATION PROJECT I-433; AND STATION PROJECT S-494, MCDONALD ISLAND, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

On 30 October 2017, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability granting coverage under the State Water Resources Control Board's *Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality* (Order 2003-003-DWQ) to Pacific Gas and Electric Company for discharges to land from Projects R-838, I-433, and S-494.

Your Notice of Termination, dated 14 August 2018, states that no further discharges from the project will occur and you wish to terminate coverage under the General Waste Discharge Requirements. Based on that information, coverage under Order 2003-003-DWQ-0182 is hereby rescinded.
