***TRANSMITTAL OF ORDER RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS,
CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, CONSTRUCTION
DEWATERING, STATE ROUTE 20 SMARTSVILLE SAFETY IMPROVEMENT
PROJECT (03-2F590), YUBA AND NEVADA COUNTIES***

On 13 June 2018, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability granting coverage under the State Water Resources Control Board's *Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality* (Order 2003-0003-DWQ) to California Department of Transportation for discharges to land from construction dewatering for the Smartsville Safety Improvement Project.

Your Notice of Termination dated 27 May 2020, states that no further discharges from the project will occur and you wish to terminate coverage under the General Waste Discharge Requirements. Based on that information, coverage under Order 2003-0003-DWQ-0188 is hereby rescinded.
