RESCISSION OF COVERAGE UNDER WATER QUALITY ORDER 2003-0003-DWQ, STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND WITH A LOW THREAT TO WATER QUALITY, GREAT WOLF LODGE CONSTRUCTION DEWATERING, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

On 10 December 2018, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) issued a Notice of Applicability granting coverage under the State Water Resources Control Board's *Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality* (General Order; 2003-0003-DWQ) to the Great Wolf Lodge for construction dewatering.

The Central Valley Water Board received a Notice of Termination, dated 8 February 2022, stating that the project is complete and discharges to land have ceased. Based on that information, coverage under Order 2003-0003-DWQ-0190 is hereby rescinded.
