RESCISSION OF COVERAGE UNDER WATER QUALITY ORDER 2003-0003-DWQ, STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND WITH A LOW THREAT TO WATER QUALITY, FEATHER RIVER BRIDGE PROJECT (EA NO. 03-3F560), YUBA COUNTY

On 30 March 2021, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) issued a Notice of Applicability granting coverage under the State Water Resources Control Board's *Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality* (General Order; 2003-0003-DWQ) to the California Department of Transportation for construction dewatering.

The Central Valley Water Board received a Notice of Termination on 17 May 2022 stating that discharges to land have ceased. Based on that information, coverage under Order 2003-0003-DWQ-0217 is hereby rescinded.
