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RESCISSION OF COVERAGE UNDER WATER QUALITY ORDER 2003-0003-DWQ, STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND WITH A LOW THREAT TO WATER QUALITY; SALMONID HABITAT RESTORATION AND FISH PASSAGE, BIG NOTCH, FREMONT WEIR – YOLO BYPASS, YOLO COUNTY

On 23 September 2022, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability granting coverage under State Water Resources Control Board's Water Quality General Order 2003-0003-DWQ (General Order) to Goodfellow Brothers, Inc and the California Department of Water Resources for land discharges associated with construction dewatering activities. The discharge was assigned enrollee number **2003-0003-DWQ-0237**.

On 8 January 2026, a Notice of Termination was received stating that construction activities have been completed and all discharges to land have ceased. Therefore, coverage under the General Order is hereby rescinded.
