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CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP; WORD OF LIFE FELLOWSHIP, INC.; JENNESS PARK CHRISTIAN CAMP WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM; NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY 2014-0153-DWQ-R5370; FRESNO COUNTY

On 9 May 2025, Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) staff received a signed Form 200 for a change of ownership for the Jenness Park Christian Camp Wastewater Treatment System (WWTF). The WWTF was enrolled for regulatory coverage under State Water Resources Control Board Water Quality Order 2014-0153-DWQ, *General Waste Discharge Requirements for Small Domestic Wastewater Treatment Systems* (General Order) on 22 June 2022 by Notice of Applicability (NOA) 2014-0153-DWQ-R5370. The NOA identifies Acts 2 Campus Network as the owner/operator of the WWTF and the land. The May 2025 Form 200 lists Word of Life Fellowship, Inc. as the new owner of the WWTF and the land, and lists Jenness Park Christian Camp as the operator.

This letter recognizes Word of Life Fellowship, Inc., and Jenness Park Christian Camp, collectively, as the Discharger responsible for complying with the General Order and NOA 2014-0153-DWQ-R5370 (including Monitoring and Reporting Program [MRP] 2014-0153-DWQ-R5370). Please note that as the Discharger, you are required to submit self-monitoring reports specified in the MRP and pay future annual fees. Salt Control Program

On 5 January 2021, the Central Valley Water Board issued the previous owner, Acts 2 Campus Network, a Notice to Comply under the Salt Control Program for the WWTF (**CV-SALTS ID: 2793**). The Notice to Comply required the Discharger to submit a Notice of Intent (NOI) for the Salt Control Program to the Central Valley Water Board by 15 July 2021. An NOI electing Pathway 2, Alternative Salinity Permitting Approach for the Salt Control Program, was submitted for the WWTF on 14 July 2021. Pathway 2 requires permittees to participate and provide financial support to the Prioritization and Optimization (P&O) Study. As of the date of this letter, the WWTF is current with its payments for the P&O Study through 2025.

Nitrate Control Program

Concerning the Nitrate Control Program, the Facility is located outside of the valley floor and is not in a prioritized groundwater basin/subbasin, and is not subject to the Nitrate Control Program, at this time. However, a Notice to Comply with the Nitrate Control Program may be issued at a later date if the Central Valley Water Board Executive Officer determines it is necessary to protect water quality. Under these circumstances, it may be necessary to modify the NOA to incorporate applicable Nitrate Control Program findings and requirements.

This letter only confirms changes in ownership and operators and designates entities that are responsible for complying with the General Order and NOA (i.e., the Dischargers) but does not authorize material changes associated with treatment operations at the Facility. If you desire to make material changes to the wastewater treatment system, the design flow, and/or quality/location of the discharge, you must submit a new Report of Waste Discharge.
