***RESCISSION OF COVERAGE UNDER WATER QUALITY ORDER 97-10-DWQ,
SACRAMENTO MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT, RANCHO SECO NUCLEAR
GENERATING STATION DOMESTIC WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY,
SACRAMENTO COUNTY***

On 16 June 2009, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability (NOA) granting coverage under the State Water Resources Control Board's *General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges to Land by Small Domestic Wastewater Treatment Systems*, Order 97-10-DWQ (General Order) to the Sacramento Municipal Utility District (SMUD). Order 97-10-DWQ-R5019 was issued to regulate the discharge of secondary treated effluent to an artificial wetlands pond, a spray disposal area, and an overflow effluent storage pond. In addition, Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) R5-2009-0825 was issued to SMUD which specifies monitoring and reporting requirements to be implemented.

Our Compliance and Enforcement Unit issued a 6 February 2017 letter approving your 23 December 2016 *Wastewater Treatment System Closure Report* and recommended rescission of Order 97-10-DWQ-R5019. Therefore, coverage under the General Order and MRP R5-2009-0825 is hereby rescinded.
