RESCISSION OF COVERAGE UNDER WATER QUALITY ORDER NO. 97-10-DWQ-R5075, SMALL DOMESTIC WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEMS, VERONA VILLAGE RESORT AND MARINA WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY, SUTTER COUNTY

On 24 June 2011, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) issued a Notice of Applicability granting coverage under the General Waste Discharge Requirements for Small Domestic Wastewater Treatment Systems Order WQ 97-10-DWQ to the Verona Village Resort and Marian in Sutter County.

The Central Valley Water Board received a Notice of Termination on 12 October 2022 stating that discharges to land have ceased because the facility burned down in August 2017. If the facility is rebuilt and plans to discharge waste to land again, the Discharger is required to apply for a new permit. Based on that information, coverage under Order 97-10-DWQ-R5075 is hereby rescinded.
