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NOTICE OF TERMINATION; LOW THREAT GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER R5-2013-0074-100, CITY OF TRACY, LINCOLN PARK WELL REHABILITATION PROJECT; SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

On 3 May 2016 our office received a request from the City of Tracy (City) for termination of coverage for the Lincoln Park Well Rehabilitation Project under the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board's Low Threat General Order R5-2013-0074, which covered discharges to surface water associated with the rehabilitation of the City's Lincoln Park Well. The City has completed the well rehabilitation and current operational discharges from the Lincoln Park Well are made to the City's storm water system. The operational discharges are covered under State Water Resources Control Board Order 2013-0001-DWQ (NPDES Permit No. CAG995001), Waste Discharge Requirements for Storm Water Discharges from Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems.

Except for purposes of enforcement, coverage under Low Threat General Order R5-2013-0074-100 (WDID No. 5B39NP00060) is hereby terminated as of 3 May 2016 through this letter and invoicing will be modified accordingly. Please note that you must still submit your last quarterly monitoring report required under the Low Threat General Order to the Compliance/Enforcement staff. Failure to do so subjects you to mandatory minimum penalties or discretionary penalties.
