TERMINATION OF GENERAL ORDER NO. R5-2008-0085, NPDES NO. CAG #915001, NEW WEST PETROLEUM #1003 (AKA FLAG CITY SHELL), 6437 WEST BANNER STREET, LODI, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY (RB CASE #391163)

On 17 August 2011, Regional Board staff (Staff) received a request from your consultant, Advanced GeoEnvironmental, Inc., to terminate the General Permit R5-2008-0085 for the discharge of treated groundwater at your Site. The request states the groundwater pump and treatment system was taken out of service, all remedial efforts were completed with a successful contaminant rebound test, and Staff agreed on 10 August 2011 to the termination of groundwater treatment prior to issuance of a low risk closure for your Site. Therefore, your project does not require a discharge permit from the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board. Staff concurs with your request for termination of coverage under the General Permit R5-2008-0085 as reasonable and appropriate. This project was started in September 2006 and completed in August 2011. Effective immediately, this permit is terminated.
