ORDER R5-2015-0091

RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS/NPDES PERMITS

- a. Waste Discharge Requirements Order 88-028, adopted on 26 February 1988, prescribes requirements to Calaveras County Water District and John Lemke for the discharge of domestic wastewater to a community leachfield system. The District has closed the leachfield and installed a pumping station to redirect the wastewater to the City of Arnold's sewer system. Therefore, it is appropriate to rescind WDRs Order 88-028.

- b. Waste Discharge Requirements Order R5-2006-0071, adopted on 23 June 2006, prescribes requirements for the discharge of biosolids to land at Jess Ranch and Marciel Ranch in Alameda County. In response to a Notice of Violation issued on 24 September 2013, Cleanup and Abatement Order (CAO) R5-2014-0700 was adopted by the Board on 3 March 2014 to mitigate impacts of illegal dumping inconsistent with the requirements of the WDRs. Since issuance of the CAO, the application of biosolids at Jess Ranch and Marciel Ranch has been discontinued and all technical reports required by the CAO have been received and approved. Therefore, it is appropriate to rescind WDRs Order R5-2006-0071.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above NPDES and WDR orders are rescinded.
