## RESCISSION OF COVERAGE UNDER CONDITIONAL WAIVER OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR SMALL FOOD PROCESSORS AND SMALL WINERIES WITHIN THE CENTRAL VALLEY REGION, BLACK VETTE WINERY, PLACER COUNTY

On 01 July 2020, the Executive officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability granting coverage under the *Conditional Waiver of Waste Discharge Requirements for Small Food Processors, Wineries, and Related Agricultural Processors within the Central Valley Region*, Order R5-2020-0002 (the Waiver). You were assigned Order R5-2020-0002-0006.

On 04 March 2021 we received your letter informing us of the closure of your facility, and request for termination of coverage under R5-2020-0002. You state that the winery is closed and you will no longer produce wine at this location. Based on this information, Order R5-2020-0002-0006 is hereby rescinded.
