TENTATIVE ORDER TO AMEND CEASE AND DESIST ORDER R5-2015-0128-01 FOR COLLINS PINE COMPANY, CHESTER SAWMILL, WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER R5-2009-0015 (NPDES No. CA0004391), CHESTER, PLUMAS COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is a tentative order that amends Cease and Desist Order R5-2015-0128-01 for Collins Pine Company's (Discharger) Chester Sawmill (Facility). For full consideration, any comments or recommendations concerning the tentative order must be submitted in writing to the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board's (Central Valley Water Board) Redding office by **5:00 pm on 19 October 2017**. Written materials submitted after this date and time will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party. Please note that the tentative documents will receive internal legal and management review during the public comment period.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the tentative order at its **7/8 December 2017 Board Meeting**. The notice of public hearing (4 copies) and a copy of a proof of posting form are also enclosed. As soon as possible, please post one (1) copy of the notice of public hearing at:

- The entrance to the Facility;
- The nearest city hall or county courthouse;
- The nearest post office (if allowed)

Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by **26 September 2017**.


