### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING Updated Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Treatment System Former Kearney-KPF Facility

#### TO ALL INTERESTED AGENCIES, GROUPS AND PERSONS:

The Central Valley Water Board has prepared draft updated Waste Discharge Requirements for the former Kearney-KPF facility at 1624 East Alpine Avenue in Stockton. Before 1986, manufacturing activities at the former Kearney-KPF facility resulted in disposal of chemicals including chlorinated solvents to the ground and underlying groundwater. Since 1993 Kearney has been cleaning up the groundwater using a Groundwater Treatment and Disposal System. The updated Waste Discharge Requirements include updates in the treatment process description and property ownership. The updates are intended to be in line with the requirements of the Department of Toxic Substances Control Post-Closure Permit for the site.
