A tentative Waste Discharge Requirements Order (Order) is proposed for the Coastal Partners, LLC (Permittee), Vehicle Inspection Center Project (Project) in Placer County. The Project consists of the commercial development of a vehicle inspection center on a 111.6-acre parcel located to the west of Industrial Way, north of West Sunset Boulevard, east of North Foothills Boulevard, and south of Athens Avenue in Placer County. Development of the parcel requires the fill of 0.976 acre of seasonal march, 0.375 acre of seasonal wetland, 0.026 acre of stream channel, 0.281 acre of vernal pool, and 6.067 acres of wetlands, waters deemed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to be outside of federal jurisdiction, in order to create useable development space.

The tentative Order provides details of the proposed Project activities, including compensatory mitigation measures planned to compensate for the permanent loss of waters of the state and requiring avoidance and minimization measures to reduce on-site impacts during construction activities. The tentative Order describes technical conditions required to be met throughout the implementation of construction activities that allow for activities to meet Basin Plan objectives.

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. Interested persons may not cross-examine witnesses and will not be subject to cross-examination. Interested persons may submit evidence (e.g., photographs, eye-witness testimony, monitoring data) if the evidence is submitted in accordance with the deadlines for submitting evidence described below. Interested persons who present evidence may be subject to cross-examination. Interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **5 p.m. on 19 January 2021**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this item must submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Central Valley Water Board via email to Lynn.Coster@waterboards.ca.gov no later than by **5:00 p.m. on 19 January 2021**. Written materials submitted after 5:00 p.m. on the above date will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record absent a ruling by the Board Chair. Any party requesting to submit late materials must demonstrate good cause for the late submission, and the Chair must find that the late submission would not prejudice the Central Valley Water Board or any designated party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Central Valley Water Board meeting and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
