## for COUNTY OF TULARE FOR OPERATION, CONSTRUCTION, AND CORRECTIVE ACTION FOR WOODVILLE DISPOSAL SITE TULARE COUNTY

Enclosed are the tentative revised Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) and Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) for the Woodville Disposal Site.
