RESPONSE TO COMMENTS REGARDING TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS, CITY OF RIO VISTA LANDFILL, SOLANO COUNTY

The attached document notes the absence of written comments received by the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board from interested persons regarding the tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for the closed Rio Vista Landfill in Solano County circulated on 3 August 2022. Written comments were required by public notice to be received by the Central Valley Water Board by 2 September 2022 to receive full consideration.

The Central Valley Water Board staff made minor changes to the tentative WDRs to improve clarity and fix typographical errors.
