## NOTICE TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND PUBLIC HEARING

## MERCED COUNTY REGIONAL WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY CONSTRUCTION, MONITORING, CORRECTIVE ACTION, AND OPERATION, FOR BILLY WRIGHT SOLID WASTE LANDFILL MERCED COUNTY

Enclosed are the tentative revised Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) and Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) for the Billy Wright Solid Waste Landfill. Also enclosed is a Notice of Public Hearing (NOPH) to interested parties, pursuant to section 21730 of Title 27, California Code of Regulations. These tentative revised WDRs were initially issued for public comment on 6 December 2022. However, these tentative WDRs are being re-circulated for public comment since they have been revised to incorporate additional requirements. The enclosed NOPH describes the date, time, and place that the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) is scheduled to have a hearing to consider the adoption of the tentative WDRs.

Any comments or recommendations that you may have concerning the tentative WDRs should be submitted to this office in writing by 5:00 p.m. on **10 March 2023** so that consideration may be given to them prior to the meeting of the Central Valley Water Board.
