This document contains the responses to written comments received from interested parties regarding the proposed tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for the Billy Wright Solid Waste Landfill in Merced County regulating construction, monitoring, corrective action and operation of the landfill. Tentative WDRs R5-2023-XXXX were prepared as part of a policy of administrative review. Currently, the facility is regulated under WDRs R5-2022-0029 and R5-2011-0061. The Tentative WDRs were circulated on 8 February 2023 for public comment, ending on 10 March 2023. A total of one email was received and these comments are addressed below.
