NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

A tentative Waste Discharge Requirements Order (Order) is proposed for the Caltrans (Permittee), Keene Pavement 09-37920 Project (Project) in Kern County. The Project consists of improving traffic flow and operational performance on a steep grade segment of State Route 58 where truck speeds fall significantly below posted limits. The Project also aims to improve commuter travel, support freight movement through the corridor, restore roadway conditions to minimize maintenance needs, extend the service life of the facility, and reduce collision rates along four identified curves. Direct impacts to waters of the state result from drainage upgrades required to rehabilitate and preserve the State Route 58 corridor. The work activities within aquatic resources involves in-kind replacement of culverts, drop inlets, overside drains, and down drains. All impacted waters have been deemed by U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to be outside of federal jurisdiction.

The tentative Order provides details of the proposed Project activities, including compensatory mitigation measures planned to compensate for the permanent loss of waters of the state and requiring avoidance and minimization measures to reduce on-site impacts during construction activities. The tentative Order describes technical conditions required to be met throughout the implementation of construction activities that allow for activities to meet Tulare Lake Basin Plan water quality objectives and other regulatory requirements.

The agenda will provide the anticipated date the hearing will be held for this item and anticipated order of all agenda items; however, the Board may consider agenda items out of their listed order. The agenda materials may also include staff revisions to the tentative Order.

Nature and Purpose of Hearing

At the hearing, the Central Valley Water Board will hear testimony and oral comments regarding the tentative Order. This proceeding will be a formal adjudicatory proceeding. Prehearing Submission of Written Comments and Evidence

The **Permittee** is a party to this proceeding and may present evidence, including oral testimony. As a party, the Permittee must submit written evidence or comments, if any, for the Board to consider no later than **5:00 p.m. on 11 May 2026** via email to centralvalleyfresno@waterboards.ca.gov and copy Brandon.Salazar@waterboards.ca.gov.

Interested persons include any non-party that is interested in the outcome of the hearing. Interested persons wishing to comment in writing on the tentative Order shall submit comments no later than **5:00 p.m. on 11 May 2026** via email to centralvalleyfresno@waterboards.ca.gov and copy Brandon.Salazar@waterboards.ca.gov.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 23, section 648.4, the Board Chair may refuse to admit written evidence or comments that are not submitted in accordance with this Notice and shall refuse to do so when there is a showing of prejudice to the Permittee or the Board. Excluded material will not be considered by the Board.

Visual Presentations

Hearing participants may use PowerPoint or other visual presentations at the hearing, but the presentation content shall not exceed the scope of previously submitted written material. Hearing Procedure and Time Limits

The hearing on the tentative Order will be conducted in the general order listed under California Code of Regulations, title 23, section 648.5, except that the Board Chair may modify the order for good cause.

The Permittee and any other designated Party will be advised in advance of the hearing of the total amount of time allocated for their presentation, including any witness examination, and closing statement. The Permittee and any other designated Party are invited to contact staff in advance of the hearing to discuss how much time they believe is necessary.

Interested persons may speak at the hearing and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals, if any. Each interested person will have three minutes to present oral comments. Additional time may be provided, upon request, at the discretion of the Board Chair.

The hearing facilities will be accessible to persons with disabilities.
