TENTATIVE ORDER R5-2026-XXXX

RESCINDING CEASE AND DESIST ORDER NO. R5-2007-0101

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region, finds that the Board adopted the following Cease and Desist Order, which is no longer applicable for the reasons described below:

A) CEASE AND DESIST ORDER NO. R5-2007-0101 REQUIRING THE CITY OF SAN JOAQUIN, FRESNO COUNTY, TO CEASE AND DESIST FROM DISCHARGING WASTE IN VIOLATION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER NO. R5-2007-0100

Cease and Desist Order (CDO) No. R5-2007-0101, adopted on 2 August 2007, required the City of San Joaquin (Discharger) wastewater treatment facility (WWTF) to cease and desist discharging wastes in violation and threatened violation of Waste Discharge Requirements Order R5-2007-0100 (WDRs). The CDO required the Discharger to submit a technical report that includes the final design for all projects associated with a proposed WWTF expansion project described in the Discharger's 23 January 2007 Report of Waste Discharge, complete construction of the WWTF expansion project, submit a technical report containing a detailed flow schematic of the upgraded WWTF, and certification report for the lined treatment pond and sludge drying beds. Additionally, the CDO required the Discharger to submit an Operations and Maintenance Manual for the upgraded WWTF.

The Discharger has completed its WWTF expansion project and submitted the technical reports and other documents required by the CDO. The Discharger has met the requirements of the CDO. Therefore, it is appropriate to rescind CDO R5-2007-0101.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above Order is rescinded.
