The Final Agenda will provide the location and format of the meeting, the anticipated date that the proposed order will be considered, and the anticipated order of all agenda items; however, the Board may consider agenda items out of their listed order. The agenda materials may also include staff revisions to the proposed order.

Opportunities to Comment

The Central Valley Water Board will consider oral and written comments on the proposed Order before it votes on whether to adopt the Order.

Written comments or evidence concerning the Order must be submitted by 5:00 p.m. on 22 April 2026. The Board Chair may refuse to admit any comments or evidence received after the comment period unless the submitting party provides a reasonable explanation for why the submission is late and the Board Chair determines that admission of the late submission would not prejudice any other party.

Oral comments concerning the Order must be presented at the scheduled public meeting.

Parties to the Proceeding and Interested Persons

Participants in the hearing will be considered "parties" or "interested persons." Parties include the person or persons to whom the agency action is directed (i.e., the Modesto Management Zone, the dischargers regulated under the order, and their representatives) and other persons whom the Board determines should be designated as a party. Parties may present written evidence, offer witness testimony, cross-examine witnesses, and provide closing statements.

Interested Persons are those persons and organizations that are interested in the outcome of the hearing who have not been designated as a party. Interested Persons may present written or oral non-evidentiary policy statements but are not subject to cross-examination.

Both Parties and Interested Persons may be asked to respond to questions from the Board or its staff. Interested persons are generally allowed up to three minutes each to provide their comments. If additional time to speak at the hearing is needed, both interested persons and parties shall make a request for more time by the **22 April 2026** deadline.

Persons and organizations other than the Management Zone, the dischargers regulated under the order, and their representatives may request to be designated as a party to the proceeding by submitting a written statement describing why they would like to be considered a designated party. Specifically, the request should state the persons' interest in presenting evidence, rather than policy statements and legal argument, and an acknowledgement that those testifying may be subject to cross examination consistent with applicable regulations. Such requests must be submitted to the Central Valley Water Board at 11020 Sun Center Drive, #200 Rancho Cordova, CA 95670 or by email to robert.ditto@waterboards.ca.gov no later than 5:00 p.m. on **22 April 2026**.

Due to the complexity of the policy issues involved in the hearing, both interested persons and parties to the proceeding may work together to consolidate their comments into panel presentations, which will allow participants more time to present evidence, policy statements, or legal argumentation to the Board. If you would like to provide a panel presentation, please email robert.ditto@waterboards.ca.gov with the subject line "Modesto Management Zone Order" by no later than 1 May 2026 with the names, affiliations, and email addresses of each member of the panel and whether each panel member will present.

All hearing participants that would like to make a PowerPoint presentation during their panel presentation must submit it to robert.ditto@waterboards.ca.gov by no later than 5:00 pm on 22 May 2026.

Proposed Order

As part of the Central Valley Water Board's Nitrate Control Program, the Modesto Management Zone prepared a proposed Implementation Plan, called an MZIP, that lays out the Management Zone's plan for providing interim and long-term drinking water to households whose drinking water sources are impacted by Management Zone members' discharges of nitrate, for reducing or otherwise addressing those members' nitrate discharges, and for restoring nitrate-impacted groundwater basins where reasonable, feasible, and practicable. The MZIP also proposes, on behalf of Management Zone members, exceptions from implementation of the water quality objectives for nitrate for terms of 10-35 years to provide time for Management Zone members to address their nitrate discharges.

The Central Valley Water Board will be considering whether to approve the proposed exceptions, which will be conditioned on the Management Zone and its members'

completion of requirements outlined in the Order and its attachments. While the Order outlines the Management Zone's responsibilities and duties under the Nitrate Control Program, the Order attachments outline Management Zone members' (i.e., individual dischargers) responsibilities and duties. These attachments include modifications to Order R5-2012-0116-11, *Waste Discharge Requirements General Order for Growers within the Eastern San Joaquin River Watershed that are Members of a Third-Party Group*, as well as Model Monitoring and Reporting Program Orders (MRPs) for dairies, bovine facilities, poultry facilities, and Non-15 facilities (e.g., wastewater treatment plants), respectively.

Additionally, this Order includes minor modifications to Order R5-2017-0058, Waste Discharge Requirements General Order for Confined Bovine Feeding Operations, and R5-2016-0087-01, Waste Discharge Requirements General Order for Poultry Operations, in order to create a streamlined process for incorporating Nitrate Control Program-related requirements into specific dischargers' waste discharge requirements if and when such incorporation becomes necessary. Dischargers whose requirements may be modified via this streamlined process will be notified and have opportunity to comment before any such modifications occur.
