The Central Valley Water Board is inviting the public and other stakeholders to submit written comments on the following Surface Water Quality Management Plans:

The Irrigated Lands Regulatory Program (ILRP) implements surface water monitoring requirements to protect beneficial uses and ensure irrigated agricultural operations comply with water quality objectives outlined in applicable Basin Plans. Under ILRP General Orders, a Surface Water Quality Management Plan must be developed and implemented when a water quality objective is exceeded more than once within a three-year period at a specific monitoring site.
