I am writing to encourage the Central Valley Regional Water Control Board to enforce current deadlines for compliance with nutrient and sediment reduction requirements rather than granting a lengthy extension to parties whose activities impact the water quality of Clear Lake, or who are responsible for regulating such activities. As a Lake County resident I am heartbroken by the negligence that has allowed the lake to become so degraded.
