As a citizen of Lake County since 2004 I have followed the unfortunate non-development of the Watershed Protection District from its beginning. It's lack of development and State mandated function is due to insufficient funding and poor management by its Board of Directors, the Board of Supervisors, who appear to fail to carry out the quality of protection needed for responsible care of Clear Lake. To continue in this inadequate manner of mandated protection for Watershed and Lake is unacceptable by most any standard of consideration, and certainly for residents of Lake County.

Not only are the water quality conditions and amount of nutrients entering the lake not met by the current TMDL standard, but the TMDL itself is questionable as sufficient means of measurement. Attention to Clear Lake water quality has suffered County and State neglect, and rather than extending this neglect for so many more years, let's put some teeth in actions to properly repair and restore this historic lake, NOW.
