ORDER NO. 80-75

RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

The California Regional Water Quality Board, Colorado River Basin Region finds that:

1. The below-listed Board Orders contain waste discharge requirements for waste discharge facilities that are no longer in use, have been converted for use by establishments with minor discharges, or were never constructed.
2. It is desirable to rescind said below-listed Board Orders.
3. The Board forwarded timely notices by mail to persons responsible for each of the below-listed Orders, or who submitted the original reports of waste discharge, explaining the Board's considerations of rescinding the particular Order, and requesting timely comments.
4. The Board at a public hearing heard and considered all comments pertaining to the proposed rescinding of the below-listed Orders.
