**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR
DISCHARGE PERMIT**

The following discharger has filed an application for renewal of Waste Discharge Requirements (Proposed Order No. R7-2006-0060) for the following site:

**PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY
PG&E TOPOCK COMPRESSOR STATION
GROUNDWATER INJECTION
Southeast of Needles – San Bernardino County**

The Board's staff has prepared a proposed Board Order for the above discharger (PG&E (77 Beale Street, San Francisco, CA 94105)). Proposed Order R7-2006-0060 would replace Order R7-2004-0103 that is scheduled to expire January 31, 2007. The proposed Order would authorize PG&E to continue to discharge 135 gallons per minute of treated groundwater to two injection wells (IW-2 and IW-3). The Discharger currently operates a treatment facility to treat groundwater contaminated with Chromium VI and to maintain hydraulic control of the contaminated groundwater plume boundaries. Extracted groundwater is treated with chemical reduction, precipitation, and solids removal by gravity or clarifier. Reverse Osmosis (RO) is used as a polishing step for the treated water to reduce Total Dissolved Solids (TDS). Under this proposed Order, the treated water would be injected into groundwater and RO concentrate and other associated liquid wastes would be discharged to an appropriate disposal facility. The Regional Board will consider adopting the proposed Board Order during a Public Hearing that will commence at the time and place indicated below:

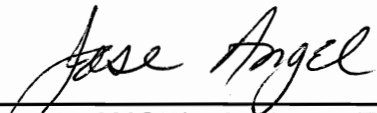

**Public Notice of
Intent to Adopt a Negative Declaration
For
Renewal of Waste Discharge Requirements**

**Public Comment Period:
August 2, 2006 to August 31, 2006**

The public is invited to review and comment on an Initial Study and proposed Negative Declaration, prepared by the Colorado River Basin Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board), pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (California Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq.) and CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15000 et seq.), for a project consisting of the renewal of Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) regulating the injection of treated water from existing groundwater treatment facilities and injection system. The pump and treat system currently in operation is used to treat groundwater contaminated with hexavalent chromium (Chromium VI). The groundwater treatment facilities and injection system are owned and operated by Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), and are located approximately 15 miles southeast of Needles, California, near the PG&E Topock Compressor Station. Renewal of the WDRs by the Regional Water Board would allow for the continued injection of treated water during operation of the groundwater treatment facilities, which is necessary to prevent additional water quality impacts on State waters. No additional facilities would be constructed or expanded and no change to the existing groundwater treatment facility operations would occur as a result of renewal of the WDRs.

The proposed Negative Declaration is supported by the Initial Study, which evaluates whether this project may have a significant effect on the environment. The proposed Negative Declaration reflects the determination by the Regional Water Board that renewal of the WDRs will not have a significant effect on the environment. The Regional Water Board will consider adopting the proposed Negative Declaration during a **Public Hearing** that will commence at the time and place indicated below:
