Project Description:

The project involves exposing an existing natural gas pipeline to verify its conditions and make repairs at two locations (R9, R10) along Line 2001EW/1030. Work will occur within the SoCalGas right-of-way and existing access roads will be utilized. Repair work entails excavation of the line using a rubber-tired excavator. The trench will be approximately 15 feet wide and 8 feet deep. The trench will be backfilled with native material from the pipeline trench and restored to original grade. All equipment on site will be maintained to avoid leaks, oil, and residues. Temporary perimeter sediment barriers such as berms, silt fences, fiber rolls, covers, and sand/gravel bags will be in place to protect materials and spoils from stormwater runoff.

The project will temporarily impact up to 0.221 acres (67 linear feet) of Waters of the State within unnamed Washes (Ephemeral Streams) in the Hayfield Hydrologic Unit

(718.00). Temporarily impacted areas will be restored to pre-project contours upon completion. No compensatory mitigation will be required as no permanent impacts will occur.
