Item 5. Consideration of the Consent Calendar - Items below, marked with an asterisk, are expected to be routine and non-controversial. The Board will be asked to consider these items at one time without discussion. If any interested party, Board Member or staff requests that an item be removed from the consent calendar, it will be taken up in the order shown.

Item \*6. Waste Discharge Requirements for Pacific Summit-Foothill, LLC, Sycamore Heights Residential Development Project, City of Rancho Cucamonga, San Bernardino County - Authorizing discharges of 0.62 acre of fill to waters of the State and including 0.10 acre of fill to waters of the United States. The waters proposed for fill are unnamed ephemeral tributaries to Cucamonga Creek, Reach 1. The waters overlay the Cucamonga Groundwater Management Zone. The discharge of fill is associated with the development of the Sycamore Heights Residential Development, which would construct 175 condominium units and associated amenities and utilities on a 24-acre Project site. The order will serve as a Clean Water Act Section 401 Water Quality Certification for the discharge of fill to the waters of the United States over which the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers asserted jurisdiction. Waste Discharge Requirements for Three Strands Properties, LLC, Tentative Tract Map 32129 Project, City of Lake Elsinore, Riverside County, Order Number R8-2021-0026 - Authorizing discharge of 0.14 acre of fill to waters of the State. The waters proposed for fill are unnamed ephemeral tributaries to Temescal Creek, Reach 5. The discharge of fill is associated with the proposed Tentative Tract Map 32129 Project, which would construct a 27-unit residential development and associated infrastructure within an approximate 10.8 acres area. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers declined to take jurisdiction over the onsite waters. Order Number R8-2021-0026

Item \*8. Waste Discharge Requirements for Rancho Diamante Investments, LLC, Rancho Diamante TTM 35393 Phase 4 Project, City of Hemet, Riverside County

Authorizing discharge of 0.06 acre of fill to waters of the State. The waters proposed for fill are an unnamed isolated ephemeral waterway. The discharge of fill is associated with the proposed Rancho Diamante TTM 35393 Phase 4 Residential Development Project, which would subdivide 31.83 acres into 140 single-family residential lots and associated infrastructure. Change of Ownership from Rancho Diamante Investments, LLC, to Lennar Homes of California, LLC, Rancho Diamante TTM 35393 Residential Development Project City of Hemet, Riverside County, Order Number R8-2021-0029 - Ownership of the Rancho Diamante TTM35393 Project, authorized by Order Number R8-2020-0028, has been transferred from Rancho Diamante Investments, LLC, to Lennar Homes of California, Inc. Order Number R8-2021-0029 amends Order Number R8-2020-0028 and is needed to transfer the legal responsibility of the conditions of the original Order to the new owner. No other changes to the conditions have been made. The transfer was effective as of June 1, 2020. Order Number R8-2021-0029.
