<u>Aeronutronics Facility in Newport Beach</u> - Regional Board staff will provide an

update on vapor intrusion assessment activities at the former Ford Aeronutronics facility where solvents, including trichloroethylene (TCE), were historically used and have resulted in a large soil vapor plume. Staff will provide background information about vapor intrusion, summarize the risk assessments completed to date, and present the results of the ongoing vapor intrusion assessment and the soil vapor extraction pilot tests, in addition to discussing potential remediation and mitigation strategies and providing a summary of public outreach conducted to date.
