NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR TENTATIVE ORDER NO. R8-2026-0015

RECISSION AND PARTY SUBSTITUTIONS OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND MASTER RECLAMATION PERMIT FOR SPECIFIC DISCHARGERS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region (Santa Ana Water Board) is releasing for public review and comment tentative Order No. R8-2026-0015 (Tentative Order), which will serve as Recission and Party Substitutions of Waste Discharge Requirements and Master reclamation Permit for three orders as identified in Attachment "A". The orders for the dischargers listed in Attachment "A" are rescinded or revised as the discharge has ceased or the discharge will be substituted for regulatory coverage by another interested party.

The Santa Ana Water Board will hold a public hearing to consider adoption of the Tentative Order as follows:
