### **NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT AND OPPORTUNITY FOR TRIBAL ENGAGEMENT**

#### **PROPOSED UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK CASE CLOSURE PURSUANT TO HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE SECTION 25296.10 AND THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD LOW-THREAT UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK CASE CLOSURE POLICY CHEVRON ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT COMPANY (RESPONSIBLE PARTY) FORMER TEXACO/BURGER KING, 2751 W. ORANGETHORPE AVENUE, FULLERTON, ORANGE COUNTY**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT** the Santa Ana Regional Water Quality Control Board (Santa Ana Water Board) will accept comments on the proposed underground storage tank (UST) case closure for case number 083003821T (Site).

Upon review of the case, the Santa Ana Water Board may close or require the closure of any UST case if it is determined that corrective action has been completed in accordance with Health and Safety Code section 25296.10. Pursuant to State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) Resolution No. 2023-0036, the Executive Officer of the Santa Ana Water Board may close or require closure of cases that meet the criteria specified in the State Water Board's Low-Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy (Policy) adopted by State Water Board Resolution No. 2012-0016.

A copy of this notice has been provided to the responsible party, owner/operator, environmental consultant on record, agencies with authority to issue building permits, owners and occupants of the impacted property, owners and occupants of all parcels adjacent to impacted properties, the water replenishment district, the local water purveyor, the municipal water district, county water district, and special act district with groundwater management authority.

#### **OPPORTUNITY FOR TRIBAL ENGAGEMENT**

Meaningful engagement with California Native American Tribes is fundamental to the mission of the Santa Ana Water Board. This project being undertaken by the Santa Ana Water Board is the proposed closure of a UST release case and, if approved to move forward, may involve the destruction of wells used for monitoring and remediation to protect groundwater.

The requirements of Public Resources Code § 21080.3.1 (Stats. 2014, ch. 532 (AB 52)), do not apply to the proposed UST case closure. However, in accordance with

Governor's Executive Order B-10-11, as a best practice the Santa Ana Water Board hereby notifies California Native American Tribes that are traditionally and culturally affiliated with the geographic location of the Site of an engagement opportunity regarding this proposed UST case closure. The Site is located at 2751 W. Orangethorpe Avenue, Fullerton, Orange County. The geographic location of the Site can be viewed on the GeoTracker Case Record webpage for this case (see link above).

Engagement may be requested up until the close of the comment period (**12:00 noon on Friday, April 10, 2026**).
