### **Brief Description of Project:**

**Project Description:** To restore and stabilize the roadway, improve drainage in an area prone to repeated washouts during storm events, and maintain the infrastructure as needed to protect the roadway and road culverts in future storms.

**Project Activities:** Temporary stormwater and sediment-laden runoff generated during culvert installation, roadway grading, excavation, placement of ungrouted rock slope protection, and routine maintenance activities within the drainage crossing. Routine maintenance activities may include sediment removal, debris clearing, repair or replacement of culvert components, and maintenance of rock slope protection to maintain proper stormwater conveyance and roadway stability. The project is intended to improve drainage capacity and reduce erosion and sediment discharge from the roadway crossing area during storm events. Because the work involves temporary construction, constituent elements may include sediment and soil particles. However, Ops will ensure soils are compacted as necessary and will not work in flowing waters. The soils are native and not contaminated. NPDES Phase I MS4 Permit will be adhered to. Construction BMPs will be implemented.
