**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT
AND NOTICE OF FILING
DRAFT SUPPLEMENTAL ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENTATION
FOR PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN TO
ADOPT THE SALT AND NUTRIENT MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE UPPER
TEMESCAL VALLEY GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT ZONE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Santa Ana Regional Water Quality Control Board (Santa Ana Water Board) will consider adoption of an amendment to the Water Quality Control Plan for the Santa Ana River Basin (Basin Plan) to: 1) establish a new ground water management zone (GMZ), the Upper Temescal Valley that combines the existing Bedford, Lee Lake and Warm Springs Valley GMZs, 2) to adopt the water quality objectives of total dissolved solids (TDS) and nitrate as nitrogen for the Upper Temescal Valley GMZ, and 3) to incorporate the implementation plan, including the monitoring and reporting plans. Santa Ana Water Board is inviting comments on the staff report and its attachments, and the draft supplemental environmental documentation (SED) for the proposed Basin Plan amendment.
