


Dear Mr. MacLaggan:

Enclosed are copies of the Revised Tentative Order No. R9-2006-0065, NPDES Permit No. CA0109223 including Monitoring and Reporting Program and Fact Sheet, and Response to Comments about Tentative Order No. R9-2006-0065. If adopted, tentative Order No. R9-2006-0065, NPDES Permit No. CA0109223, would establish requirements for the Carlsbad Desalination Project (CDP) discharge of up to 54 million gallon per day (MGD) average daily flow using granular media filtration pretreatment technology, or 57 MGD average daily flow using membrane filtration pretreatment technology, of combined concentrated saline waste seawater and filter backwash wastewater into the Pacific Ocean via the Encina Power Station's cooling water discharge channel, in accordance with the discharge prohibitions, specifications, provisions and requirements of this Order. If adopted, Order No. R9-2006-0065 shall become effective after US EPA's review and approval.

The August 16, 2006 meeting will begin promptly at 9:00 am and will be held at the following location:

Please review and comment on the changes to the Tentative Order at your earliest convenience. It is recommended that written comments be submitted as soon as possible to amend the tentative Order, if necessary, and allow changes to the tentative Order to be fully reviewed by the Regional Board and interested parties. To ensure that the Regional Board has the opportunity to fully study and consider written material, comments should be received in the Regional Board's office no later than 5:00 P.M. on Wednesday, August 2, 2006. The final deadline for submittal of written comments, however, is August 9, 2006. Per Regional Board direction, written material submitted to the Regional Board office after the submittal deadline date will not be provided to the Regional Board. Also, it is not likely that written material will be accepted by the Regional Board on the day of the meeting.
