The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (Regional Board) is scheduled to consider adoption of tentative Order No. R9-2009-0005. A copy of the tentative Order is available at:

The tentative Order, if adopted, will prescribe a Master Reclamation Permit for the discharge of recycled water from the San Vicente Wastewater Treatment Plant to portions of the Gower Hydrologic Sub-Area.
