The purpose of this meeting is for the San Diego Water Board to obtain testimony and information from concerned and affected persons and to make decisions based on the information received. Persons who want to submit written comments or evidence on any agenda item must comply with the procedures described in the agenda and agenda notes. Persons wishing to speak at the meeting should complete an attendance card (see Note F, attached to this Notice). The San Diego Water Board requests that all lengthy comments be submitted in writing in advance of the meeting date. To ensure that the San Diego Water Board members and staff have the opportunity to fully study and consider written material, comments should be received in the San Diego Water Board's office <u>no later than noon on Tuesday, May 24, 2011*</u> and should indicate the agenda item to which it is applicable. If the submitted written material is more than 5 pages or contains foldouts, color graphics, maps, etc., <u>15 copies</u> must be submitted for distribution to the Board members and staff. <u>Written material submitted after 5:00</u> P.M. on Tuesday, May 31, 2011 will not be provided to the Board members and may not be considered by the San Diego Water Board (See Note D, attached to this Notice).

*PLEASE NOTE THAT SOME ITEMS ON THE AGENDA MAY HAVE BEEN PREVIOUSLY NOTICED WITH EARLIER DEADLINES FOR SUBMITTING WRITTEN COMMENTS OR MAY HAVE A SEPARATE HEARING PROCEDURES DOCUMENT THAT ESTABLISHES DIFFERENT DEADLINES OR PROCEDURES FOR SUBMITING WRITTEN MATERIALS. Pursuant to Title 23, California Code of Regulations, section 648.4, the San Diego Water Board may refuse to admit written testimony or evidence into the record if it is not submitted to the San Diego Water Board in a timely manner and shall refuse to do so if admitting it would prejudice any party or the board, unless the proponent demonstrates that compliance with the deadline would create an unreasonable hardship.

B. Completed Cleanup Action - 30-day Public Notice

Las Brisas Cleaners, 39840 Los Alamos Rd, Unit 2, Murrieta, CA 92652

The San Diego Water Board intends to issue a no further action letter for cleanup of an unauthorized release of perchloroethene (PCE) from a dry cleaners operation in Murrieta, CA. This public notice fulfills the Regional Board's obligation to inform the public of completed corrective action as required by California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 23, Division 3, Chapter 16, Article 11, section 2728. Five monitoring wells monitor the groundwater. PCE levels in groundwater have decreased from 48 ug/L to 6.2 ug/L. The current site conditions do not pose a threat to human health or the environment, and the unauthorized release case can be closed. The case files are available for public review by submitting a file review request to the San Diego Water Board office, or on-line from the Geotracker database. C. Completed Cleanup Action - 30-day Public Notice

Stan's Service Station, 41991 Ivy Street, Murrieta, CA 92562

The San Diego Water Board intends to issue a no further action letter for cleanup of an unauthorized release of total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH) from a former gas station in Murrieta, CA. This public notice fulfills the Regional Board's obligation to inform the public of completed corrective action as required by California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 23, Division 3, Chapter 16, Article 11, section 2728. Five monitoring wells monitor the groundwater. Remediation by soil vapor extraction and ozone sparging reduced the TPH pollution concentrations in groundwater. The current site conditions do not pose a threat to human health or the environment, and the unauthorized release case can be closed. The case files are available for public review by submitting a file review request to the San Diego Water Board office, or on-line from the Geotracker database.
